

LINCOLN, NEW HAMPSHIRE
MERRIMACK RIVER FLOOD CONTROL PROJECT

Condition of Improvement, 30 September 1984

TYPE: Local Flood Protection - Emergency repair

LOCATION: The project is located on the East Branch of the Pemigewasset River, in the town of Lincoln, Grafton County, New Hampshire.

AUTHORIZATION: Authorized under the provisions of Public Law 99, 84th Congress.

PROTECTED AREA: The project, providing flood protection along the East Branch of the Pemigewasset River in the vicinity of the Franconia Paper Company, extends for a distance of 1,450 feet downstream from an industrial diversion dam. The project design flood is 30,000 cfs.

PROJECT FEATURES: Project consist of dike restoration, flank dike, riprapping and minor channel excavation.



LOCAL COOPERATION: Operated and maintained by the town of Lincoln, New Hampshire.
