

WARE, MASSACHUSETTS  
CONNECTICUT RIVER BASIN FLOOD CONTROL PROJECT

Condition of Improvement, 30 September 1984

TYPE: Local Flood Protection - structural

LOCATION: The project extends along the Ware River and Muddy Brook in the town of Ware, Hampshire County, Massachusetts.

AUTHORIZATION: Authorized by the Chief of Engineers on 2 August 1956 through Section 205 of the 1948 Flood Control Act.

PROTECTED AREA: The project, in conjunction with the Barre Falls Reservoir, provides protection to residential, commercial, industrial and public property along the Ware River and Muddy Brook.

PROJECT FEATURES: The project consists of channel improvements, earth dikes and bridge removal. The project design flood varies from 20,000 to 22,000 cfs.



LOCAL COOPERATION: Operated and maintained by the town of Ware, Massachusetts.

construction completed:	March 1960


